BRE RACING ENGINES RETURNS AS RUMBLE QUARTER MIDGET SPONSOR ***Leading Ohio-based Engine Builder Shares in Excitement of Annual Indoor Racing Event***

ROSSBURG, OH (Sept. 25) – BRE Racing Engines, of McClure, OH, specializes in precision and attention to detail, which has led them to become one of the most respected and recognizable engine builders in the Quarter Midget racing industry. Owners Javin and Claire Mendoza see those same qualities within the operation of the Rumble in Fort Wayne presented by Jason Dietsch Trailer Sales and have continued their partnership with the annual indoor racing event to sponsor the Quarter Midget division.

Contested on a purpose-built 1/7-mile concrete oval inside Fort Wayne's (IN) Allen County War Memorial Coliseum Expo Center, the event dates this year will be December 19 and 20, 2025.

"BRE Racing Engines looks forward to sponsoring another great year at the Rumble," chimed Javin and Claire. Claire continued, "every year, those who race the Rumble come back itching for more of this exciting and challenging event."

The challenges come in the form of deviation from traditional Quarter Midget racing. First and foremost is the size of the racetrack. The industry standard for Quarter Midget racing is a 1/20-mile oval. The oval inside the Expo Center is nearly 2-and-a-half times bigger than that; resulting in much higher speeds than the racers are accustomed to. With increased speeds, drafting skills and reflexes play high dividends in a driver's performance. Drivers in the BRE Racing Engines Quarter Midget division range from five to sixteen years of age.

"The Quarter Midget division, and its young drivers, adds to the unique concept of the Rumble," noted promoter Larry Boos. "Sharing the same racetrack as the Midget, 600cc Midgets and go-karts throughout the weekend can be taunting and demanding for the younger drivers but entertaining for the race fans."

"The Rumble has been one of our most favorite events in all our years of racing," commented Javin. "The atmosphere is like none other – the size of the building, the size of the track, the size of the crowd we race in front of, and the competition level puts this event high on the 'must do' list."
