The Beltway Joins the Rumble Family

FORT WAYNE, IN (December 3, 2022) – With less than a month before the 24th running of the Rumble in Fort Wayne presented by Jason Dietsch Trailer Sales (Dec. 30/31), race teams are making final preparations and putting the finishing touches to their machines. For the Midget teams, a \$250 incentive has been put forth to put extra car into their presentation.

From the pages of Facebook, The Beltway has jumped on board to post a Best Appearing Midget enticement to the teams to shine up their entry into this year's Rumble. The annual mid-winter event will be staged inside the massive Allen County War Memorial Coliseum & Expo Center, on a purpose-built 1/6 mile concrete oval.

The Beltway features weekly live, friendly fun 1/64th scale stock car, truck, street stock, modified and sprint car racing in unique competition. Race fans are encouraged to follow The Beltway on Facebook to join in on the fun this winter.

Rumble staff members and media members in attendance will hand select three Midgets that they feel meet the criteria of being best appearing. Those three cars will be placed before the fans for vocal response. The loudest reaction will determine the winner of The Beltway Best Appearing Midget \$250 bonus.
